Reading Boot Camp

Children in first grade and older will be grouped based on skill level. Activities will focus on phonological awareness, reading decoding, encoding/spelling, and reading fluency. Various Orton-Gillingham based structured literacy approaches will be used, along with other explicit and multisensory interventions. Maximum of 4 children per group.

Meets for 2 consecutive weeks on Monday through Thursday for 2 hours during the months of June/July. Dates to be determined based on interest.

Reading & Spelling Mini Boosts

Six separate reading groups, each with a specific focus. You may register for one or more than one group depending on the area(s) of focus your child needs.

Each mini group meets for one week on Monday through Friday for 1 hour during the months of June/July. Dates to be determined based on interest.

- Mini 1:** Phonological Awareness
- Mini 2:** Word Attack (Phonics)
- Mini 3:** Sight Words
- Mini 4:** Multisyllabic Words
- Mini 5:** Reading Fluency
- Mini 6:** Spelling



Kindergarten Readiness Boost

Children entering kindergarten will benefit from learning skills for school success. We target phonological awareness, knowledge of letters and sounds, blending sounds into words, and sight words.

Meets for one week on Monday through Friday for 1.5 hours during the months of June/July. Dates to be determined based on interest.

Articulation Carryover Boost

This group is specially designed for children nearing the end of articulation therapy who are working on speech sounds at the conversational level but are not using sounds consistently.

Meets for one week on Monday through Friday for 1 hour during the months of June/July. Dates to be determined based on interest.

Social Language Boost

This group will focus on the social skills of taking turns during games and conversations, cooperative play, working as part of a group to complete tasks, and understanding and respecting others' perspectives in social situations.

Meets for one week on Monday through Friday for 1 hour during the months of June/July. Dates to be determined based on interest.

Parent/Child Playgroup

Parent(s) and their child (ages 18 mos-36 mos) will have fun playing and learning together while having a speech-language pathologist demonstrate play-based learning strategies to elicit language.

Meets for one week on Monday through Friday for 1 hour during the months of June/July. Dates to be determined based on interest.

AAC Parent Support Group

Parents needing additional support programming and using their child's AAC device for functional communication in their home environment will be assisted by a highly qualified and experienced speech-language pathologist.

Meets for one week on Monday through Friday for 1 hour during the months of June/July. Dates to be determined based on interest.

Written Language Boost

This group will focus on developing and communicating ideas in written form. Targeted areas will include techniques for a specific purpose of writing, planning, generating interesting sentences varying in length and complexity, and proofing.

Meets for one week on Monday through Friday for 2 hours during the months of June/July. Dates to be determined based on interest.

Fluency Boost

This group is specially designed for children who stutter and their parents. The speech-language pathologist will assist parent(s) and their child in the carryover of fluency strategies.

Meets for one week on Monday through Friday for 1 hour during the months of June/July. Dates to be determined based on interest.

Fast ForWord®/Reading Assistant Plus®

These research-based intensive computer programs improve foundational auditory, language, and reading skills, as well as memory, attention, processing and sequencing. Fast ForWord® and Reading Assistant Plus® programs can be done at our office or at home. Students may come into our office or use Zoom to **try the demonstration games at no charge**. Individual Language & Reading Remediation

A screening or full evaluation of your child's reading and/or language skills may be recommended to document your child's reading, language and/or speech level. Children who are current clients of Center for Speech & Language do not need further testing.
